Spiral single subject WIDE RULED notebooks and color-coordinated pocket folders

- 1 Math - Red
- 1 Social Studies - Blue
- 1 Three subject notebook for Language Arts - any color
- 1 Pocket folder for Language Arts - any color
- 1 Package WIDE RULED looseleaf - not college-ruled
- 1 Durable pocket folder for daily take home work
- 1 Zippered soft side pencil case
- 1 Blue or black pens (erasable are ok)
- 2 Red pens (for corrections and proofreading)
- 1 Box #2 pencils
- 1 Package EXPO dry erase markers (low odor)
- 1 Dry eraser
- 1 Yellow highlighter
- 1 Box of colored pencils
- 1 Box of markers
- 1 Pair of small scissors
- 2 Glue sticks (no liquid glue)
- 2 Boxes of tissues for classroom supply
- 1 Rubbermaid-type (shoebox size) plastic container to keep extra supplies on closet shelf. *Suggestion - look for one with a tight-fitting lid!

Calculator - 4 function with square root key
